

Awarded “B” for Climate Change and “A” rating for Water Security in CDP 2024

Denka Company Limited (Headquarters: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President: Toshio Imai) has won a rating of “B” for Climate Change and “A” for Water Security in the CDP 2024 scores announced on February 7, 2025.

CDP (headquartered in London) is an international non-profit organization that provides an environmental information disclosure system established in 2000 by a coalition of institutional investors around the world. It sends questionnaires on climate change, water security (water resource protection), and forest category (forest conservation) to major companies around the world, and publishes scores based on its evaluation of the transparency of each company's environmental information disclosure, management involvement, and other factors. In 2024, CDP pushed for more than 24,800 companies worldwide to disclose environmental information through this platform, scoring more than 22,000 companies, the highest ever.

Denka achieved the aforementioned recognition (“B” for Climate Change and “A” for Water Security) amidst the demand for transparency regarding the progress of corporate climate change initiatives and information disclosure, as well as the need for more sophisticated corporate governance.

Under the Mission 2030 corporate plan, which began in fiscal 2023, we have positioned the pursuit of sustainability as the cornerstone of our management. CDP has introduced a system that integrates three disclosure areas with CDP 2024, which includes marine and biodiversity information, and CDP is in the process of aligning it with the new global standard for climate-related information disclosure (IFRS S2)^{*1} issued by the International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB)^{*2}.

Denka will remain committed to appropriate disclosure of environmental information while making improvements such as setting more in-depth KPIs, deepening our understanding of specific risks and opportunities, and precisely understanding and minimizing the impact of our corporate activities on resources.

Denka Company Limited will continue contributing to people’s daily lives and society by applying its world-class chemistry know-how based on the Purpose of Mission 2030: “Make the world a better place as specialists in chemistry.”

^{*1} IFRS S2: One of the standards that make up the International Financial Reporting Standards established by the ISSB. IFRS S1 specifies the general requirements for sustainability, and IFRS S2 specifies detailed climate-related disclosure items.

^{*2} International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB): An international organization launched in November 2021 by the IFRS Foundation, which sets international accounting standards, to unify global standards in corporate sustainability information disclosure.
