Denka Company Limited (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, President and CEO: Ikuo Ishida) hereby announces that on March 9 it was selected for the fourth consecutive year as a “KENKO Investment for Health Outstanding Organization (large enterprise category~White 500~)” under a program jointly conducted by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry and the NIPPON KENKO KAIGI. This marks Denka’s fifth consecutive year of recognition as a Certified Health and Productivity Management Outstanding Organization.



The Certified Health and Productivity Management Outstanding Organizations Recognition Program recognizes companies that practice particularly outstanding health and productivity management, based on initiatives tailored to community health challenges and health promotion efforts led by the NIPPON KENKO KAIGI. The top 500 companies in the Large Enterprise Category are certified as “White 500” companies.

The Company positions maintaining and promoting the health of its employees and their families as a key management priority. In 2021, we formulated the Health Management Declaration, which articulates our principles and action guidelines for health management. Currently, led by the Wellness and DE&I Promotion Section, we are continuously advancing initiatives to implement health management in collaboration with our health insurance association and labor union.

Among our specific initiatives, we are bolstering awareness of smoking cessation programs that are available at no net cost to employees ahead of a company-wide smoking ban taking effect from April. We are also organizing activities that promote employee health, such as walking contests co-hosted by management and labor, various health seminars, and gait measurement sessions aimed at preventing falls.

Under the core values of Initiative, Integrity, and Empathy set forth in Management Plan “Mission 2030”, in terms of the value creation of human resources, one of the three growth strategies: “Business Value Creation”, “Human Resources Value Creation”, and “Management Value Creation”, Denka has been implementing health management as a strategy to make Denka a company where each and every employee is healthy in mind and body, works energetically, and can experience personal growth.
