

Awarded “A”—the Highest Possible Rating—for the First Time in CDP’s Supplier Engagement Assessment 2025

Denka Company Limited (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo, Representative Director and President: Ikuo Ishida) has been awarded an “A” rating—the highest possible rating—for the first time in the 2025 Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA) conducted by the international non-profit organization CDP*1.



This assessment evaluates governance, targets, understanding and management of Scope 3 emissions, and engagement across value chains, among other areas, based on CDP’s questionnaire on climate change. We believe that these results reflect a comprehensive assessment of our Group’s efforts to establish systems and implement various initiatives aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions, as well as our proactive disclosure of information and our efforts to identify risks and enhance collaboration with our suppliers through dialogue.

Furthermore, in the CDP surveys on climate change and water security released in January 2026, the Company received a rating of “A-” for Climate Change and an “A” rating—the highest possible rating—for Water Security for the second consecutive year.
